Detailed Overview of Awards

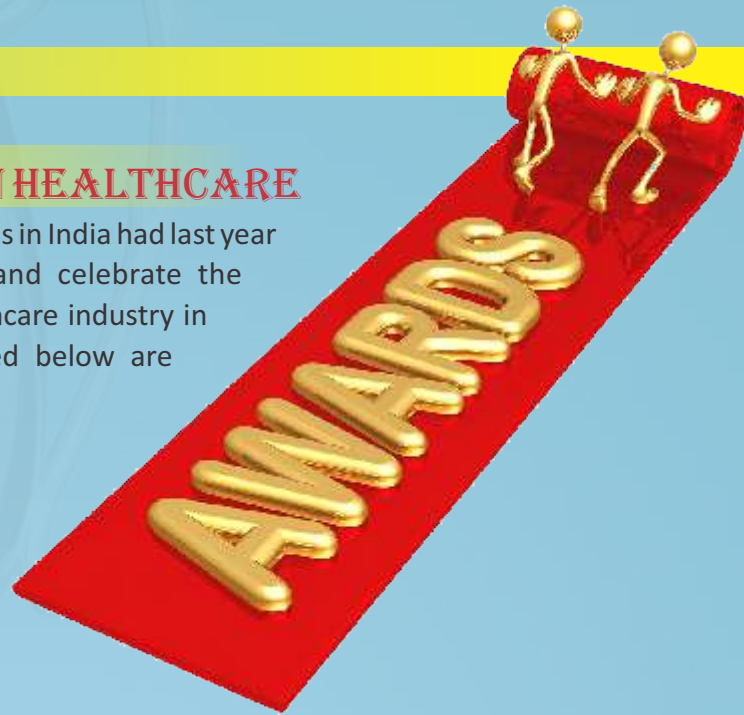
- The awards have been designed based on objective criteria.
- The applicant hospitals would be required to submit brief write up, in response to the various headings in the CRITERIA.
- Hospitals are free to apply for multiple categories.
- The AHPI Award Technical Committee will scrutinise the applications.
- The short listed hospitals will be visited by empanelled surveyors for verifying the compliance. Each award will be assessed for 1-manday.
- Findings of the Technical Committee along with the surveyor's report will be examined by the independent JURY.
- Jury will decide on the number of awards in each category and their decision will be final.

Application Fee:

The entry fee for each category of award is-

- **Rs 5000/** for hospitals **up to 100-beds**
- **Rs 10,000/** for hospitals **above 100-beds.**

CATEGORY OF AWARDS

1. Patient Friendly Hospital

Hospital would be required to submit power-point presentation (15-20 slides) in response to the criteria. This will be followed by an on-site visit.



2. Green Hospital

Hospital would be required to submit power-point presentation (15-20 slides) in response to the criteria. This will be followed by an on-site visit.

3. Quality Beyond Accreditation *(Open only to accredited hospitals)*

Hospital would be required to submit power-point presentation (15-20 slides) in response to the criteria. This will be followed by an on-site visit.



4. Outstanding Teaching Hospital

Performance of past 3 years to be judged based on:

- Results of Teaching Programs under MCI/ NBE.
- Contribution in past 3 years through innovative CMEs.

5. Nursing Excellence

Hospital would be required to submit power-point presentation (15-20 slides) in response to the criteria. This will be followed by an on-site visit.



6. Best Hospital to Work For

Hospital would be required to submit power-point presentation (15-20 slides) in response to the criteria. This will be followed by an on-site visit.

7. Excellence in Community Engagement

Based on case studies on delivering preventive/curative healthcare services to the community as social welfare activity. The short listed case studies may be validated through on-site visit.



8. Improving Maternal and Child health *(open only to State Governments)*

Improving Maternal and Child health (MMR/IMR) in state: Efforts vs Results. Government efforts and results of past 3 years to be judged. Relevant documents need to be submitted.
