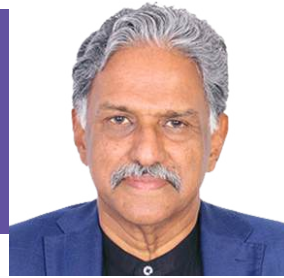

Message from Director General, AHPI

Association of Healthcare Providers (India) has completed 11-years of distinguish service for wellbeing of community at large. AHPI, though is primarily an advocacy body for healthcare providers, but while doing that job, wellbeing of community has always been upper most in our mind. All the time, AHPI has focussed on how India with huge population can come out stronger to provide affordable healthcare to society in general and underprivileged in particular. PMJAY, slowly and surely is making inroads in covering underprivileged population of our country. There are challenges in reaching out to eligible beneficiaries due to difficult terrain and in some cases lack of awareness. Once we are able to cover all those 500-million eligible population, and with other schemes like CGHS, ECHS, ESI, India will be close to be covering more than 60% of population. Adding those availing private insurance and employer insurance, India can touch close to 70% of population under some or other insurance and that will truly be great achievement by developing country like India.

While we have all the time being talking about affordability, AHPI recently undertook survey to understand issue related to accessibility and availability of healthcare services. It was realised that affordability would have relevance only when healthcare services were at first place available and accessible. Our study based on primary and secondary data available revealed that India has only less than 1.5 beds per 1000 population as against WHO norm of 3.5 beds per 1000 population. Further it was found that there exists huge disparity from state to state. For example, Karnataka has 4.2 beds per 1000 population, the Bihar on other hand has only 0.3 beds per 1000 population. AHPI has submitted complete report on this aspect to government of India as that should decide future course of policy intervention. Within the state similarly there is huge variation. For example, in the state of Tamil Nadu, the 50% of 100+ bedded hospitals are in two cities of Chennai and Coimbatore. Likewise, out of 125, 100+ bedded hospitals in Telangana, more than 100 such hospitals are in twin city of Hyderabad and Secundrabad.

Other important outcome of our study is that more than 85% of tertiary care beds are with private sector. It is incumbent that private and public sector work in tandem to make available the tertiary care to population in general and those covered under government schemes like PMJAY, CGHS etc. There exists formal arrangement that government empanel the private hospitals to make available the healthcare and in turn it makes reimbursement to the private hospitals. In principle it looks good model, except that government has not been able to arrive the rates of reimbursement on scientific basis. This deters most of tertiary and quaternary care hospitals in coming forward for empanelment and which again worsen the availability and accessibility of care. Government needs to assign task of costing of medical procedures to an authorised agency like Institute of cost accountant of India by which more hospitals will come forward for empanelment. Besides it will have big impact on financial sustainability of private sector and that will also attract more investment in healthcare in general and in deficient areas like tier-III cities in particular. AHPI has also submitted report to government on incentivising the private sector in setting up of 100-bedded tertiary care hospitals in tertiary care cities as that only will make healthcare available, accessible and affordable.

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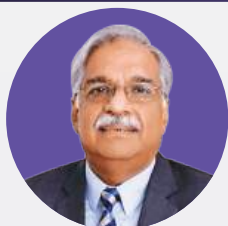

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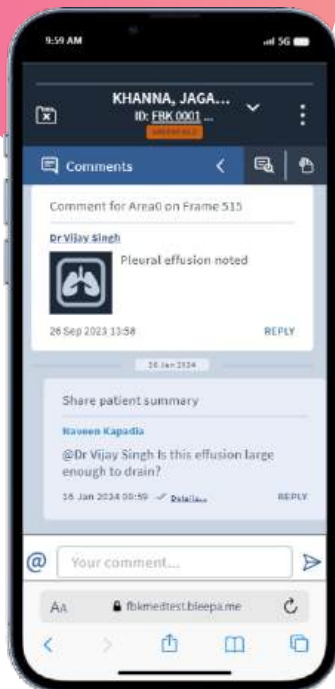


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Policy & Advocacy

AHPI continues to lobby on behalf of all the hospitals with the Government regards to the inordinate delay in the reimbursement to hospitals and the low rates for reimbursement which have not been revised since 2014. As a result of the concerted efforts we have been able to get the rates revised for OPD fees, cardiology & surgical procedures. AHPI will follow up with CGHS as they work in the process of revising other specialty rates. AHPI through its intervention was able to get an extension of the validity period of already empaneled hospitals.



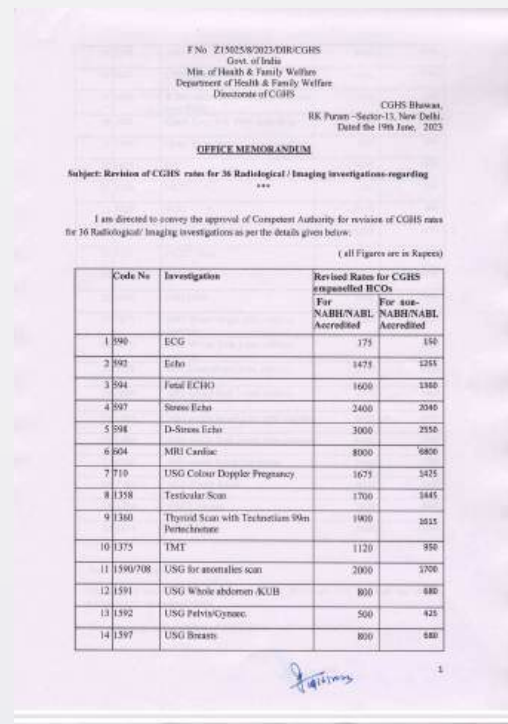

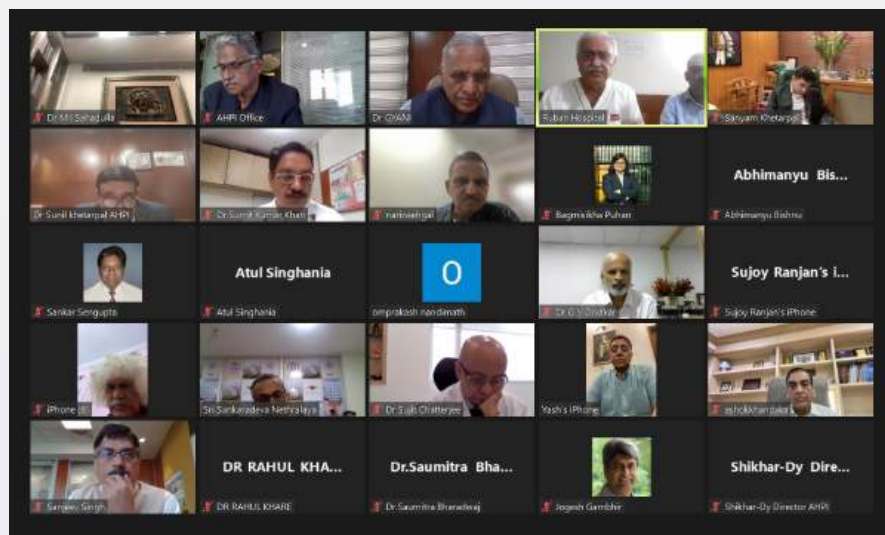

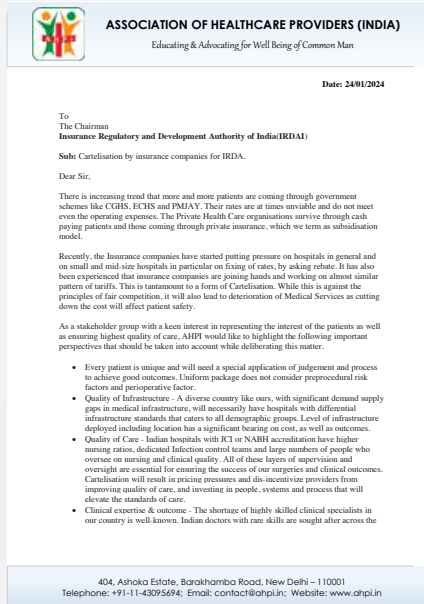

AHPI - IRDAI

One of the recent achievements of AHPI is the involvement with IRDAI in ensuring that health insurance coverage is available to individuals of all age groups. Previously, there were limitations on the maximum age at which individuals could obtain health insurance coverage, which often left older adults without the financial protection they needed for their medical expenses. However, through the efforts of AHPI being members of Health Insurance Consultative Committee (HICC) established by IRDAI, regulations have been implemented to eliminate age gaps in health insurance coverage.

The HICC including renowned healthcare professionals such as Dr. Alex Thomas and Dr. Devi Shetty, who are patrons of AHPI, submitted recommendations to IRDAI regarding this matter, which have now been implemented as regulations. 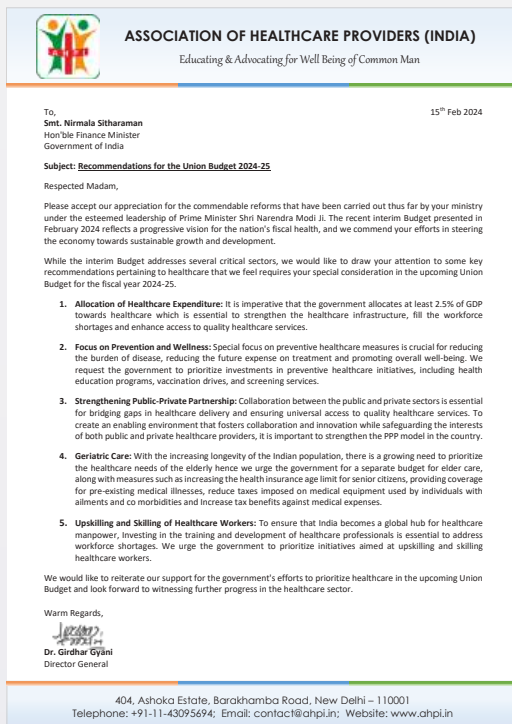

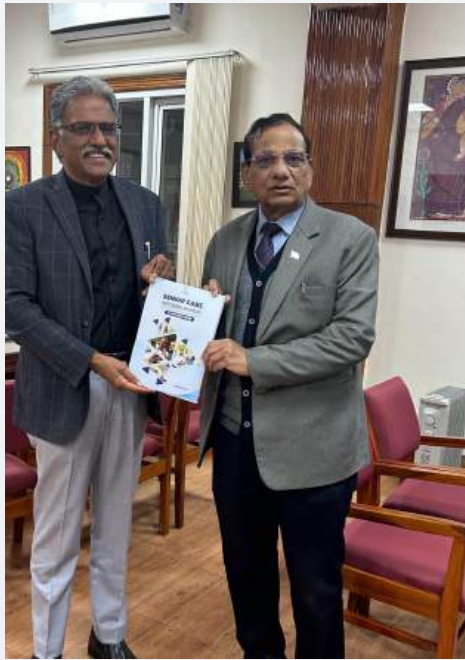

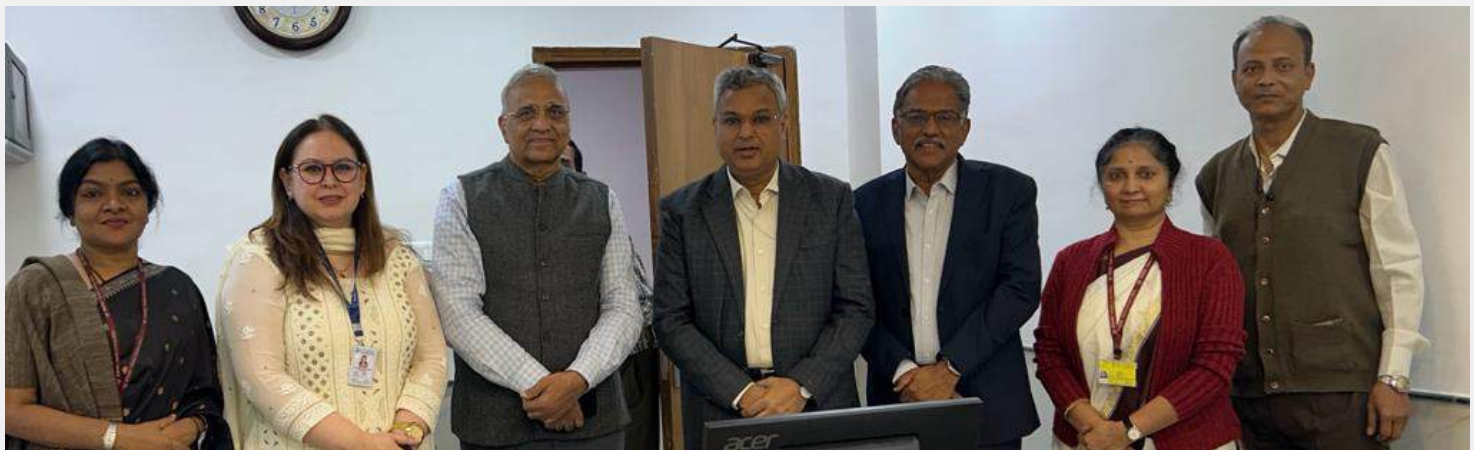

We have been raising the issue about violence against the doctors but hardly any proactive steps have been taken by the government at central as well as state level governments. Greetings from The Association of Healthcare Providers (India)

We are the representative association of majority of private hospitals in the country including hospitals of Delhi NCR.

So, we write this letter to bring into your notice the directive being imposed on the healthcare organisations which will be financially and operationally unviable, hence we request your intervention for further review in the subject matter.

As per latest directives of Commission for Air Quality Management, NCT of Delhi, issued in respect of different capacity of DG sets in NCR and surrounding States. The salient points are mentioned below:-

- There is no requirement / restriction on DG sets of all capacities running on LPG / Natural Gas/ Biogas/ Propane / Butane.
- DG sets of 19 kW to less than 125 kW – only dual fuel mode is required. Its use is restricted to only for 2 hours per day during O&AP period.
- DG sets of 125 kW to less than 800 kW are required to have Dual fuel kit and Retro-fitted ECDS through certified vendors / agencies.
- DG sets of 800 kW and above are required to have Dual fuel mode and any other ECDS. During O&AP period, its usage is restricted to 2 hours per day.
- New DG sets of all capacities up to 800 kW are required as per standards mentioned. MoEFCC notification number G-15017/06/2012-CPW and GDR 808/11 dated 02.11.2022.

The above orders need to be implemented from 30.09.2023, otherwise DG sets can't be used.

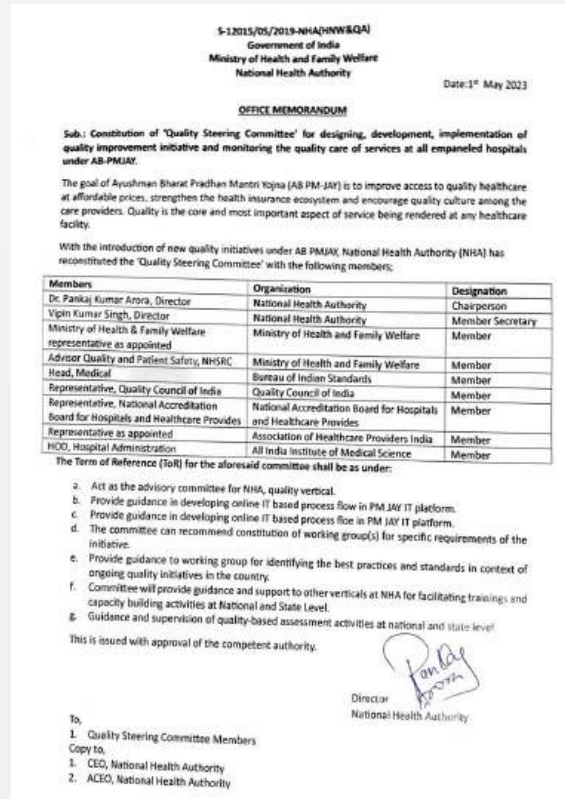
Implications of the above orders for Healthcare Facilities in Delhi NCR

- Cost of installation of RECD series from 2,000 – 3,000 rupee per KVA excluding the cost of installation, freight and GST.
- Cost of replacement of dual fuel varies from 1,250 – 2,200 rupee per KVA excluding the cost of installation, freight and GST.
- In cases where we need to install both, the cost varies between Rs 3,250 – Rs 5,200 per KVA depending on the size of DG sets. Per KVA rate of a small capacity DG set is higher than the rate for larger DG sets. Financially, this translates into
 - 125 KVA DG set installation cost will be approximately ₹,30,000/- + GST + installation + freight cost. Which will be additional approx. 20,000/- i.e. ₹,50,000/- . All healthcare facilities require at least 2 DG sets as backup in case of failure of one DG set. So the total cost of a small DG set required by a small hospital/nursing home will need an investment of 1.2-1.8 lakhs.

'Strict laws needed to stop youth from consuming tobacco products'

■ 39 per cent of CG's population consumes tobacco products

INDIAN Medical Association (IMA) Raipur and Association of Healthcare Providers India (AHP) Chhattisgarh Chapter have demanded amendment in the COTPA Act 2003 at State-level in Chhattisgarh.

A delegation led by Dr Rakesh Gupta, President, IMA Raipur and AHPI Chhattisgarh, Dr Digvijay Singh, General Secretary, IMA Raipur, Atul Singhania, General Secretary, AHPI Chhattisgarh Chapter, Dr Anil Jain, Treasurer, among others, met the Health Minister of Chhattisgarh, T S Singhdeo and brought some important points pertaining to this to the notice of Health Minister.

The delegation mentioned that according to the Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS) 2 of the Government of India, more than 13 lakh people in India die every year due to con-

sumption of tobacco and related products in the country. 39 percent of Chhattisgarh's population is suffering from the adverse effects of tobacco consumption. In our State, 53.7 percent men and 24.6 per cent women consume tobacco and related products.

According to the Global Youth Tobacco Survey 2019, 8 percent of school children aged 13 to 15 years (average age 7.3 years) in Chhattisgarh are consuming tobacco and related products and 26 percent youth are victims of passive smoking.

The delegation informed the Health Minister that the

Government of India's Central Act - Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and Regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003 (COTPA 2003) has been made with the aim of controlling and monitoring tobacco and related products.

However, there are some loopholes in the Act due to which the efforts of the Government to control the use of tobacco are being hampered.

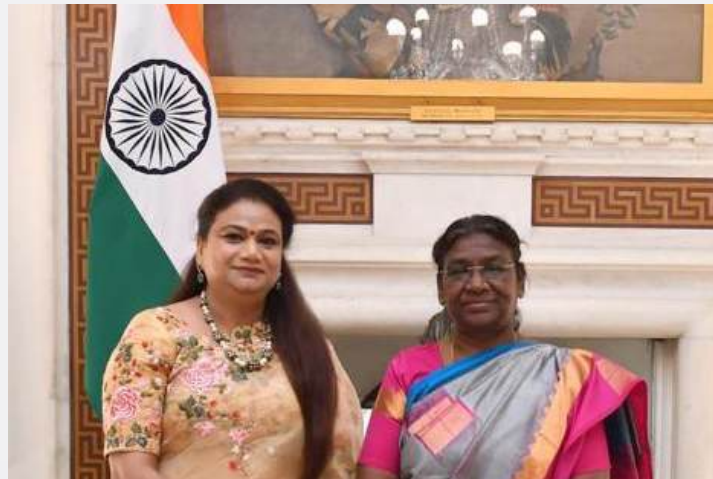

Insurance firms unfairly rejecting claims: AHPI

PNS ■ NEW DELHI

The insurance companies are "unfairly" rejecting claims by patients and blatantly disregarding guidelines laid down by the Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India, thus leaving the insured patients at the receiving end, The Association of Healthcare Providers India (AHPI) has said.

The AHPI which is a collective of hospitals and other healthcare providers has demanded action against such private insurance companies as it accused them of forming an "alarming cartel".

The AHPI contended that private insurance companies are collectively discontinuing cashless facilities provided to hospitals, depriving patients of their right to choose treatment and healthcare providers in an arbitrary manner.

"As claims are denied, individuals find themselves in urgent need of funds to cover mounting medical expenses

with escalating costs amounting losses due to the conduct of these insurance companies, the association said in a statement here.

Dr Girdhar Gyani, Director General of AHPI, said, "The AHPI's efforts to rectify this situation have been met with resistance. Multiple complaints have been filed with IRDAI, but no tangible action has been taken yet. Several members from across the nation have also reported similar harassment by insurance companies, prompting us to take these concerns seriously."

"Consequently, we are now considering legal action and approaching the Competition Commission of India to draw attention to these concerning practices. One particularly distressing case that I came across involved the sudden depanelment of one of our member hospitals in Delhi by a well-known insurance company. The insurer insisted on substantial discounts from the

In these tough infrastructure times available to provide managed healthcare to all? Will you have partners? Many global health insurance and private equity firms have approached us. However, we decline both, preferring a distinct role. We aim to avoid the constraints of past legacies and pursue innovative approaches. The IHDH has allowed us to chart our course and support outcomes after a year.

We do not plan to have millions of employees from day one. We will start with a few thousand and gradually increase the coverage. We may start with a radius of 50 km around Electronic City and gradually increase the area.

Will people be able to afford managed healthcare? Most of the patients I treat belong to the working class. When I inform a mother that her child requires an operation, the first question is not about the risk or the surgery itself but rather the cost. जालंधर, 26 दिसम्बर (धवन): भारत सरकार द्वारा संसद में 'भारतीय नागरिक सुरक्षा (सेकेड) संहिता विधेयक 2023 (सी.आर.पी.सी. को बदलने) में किए गए संशोधन का डाक्टर समुदाय ने स्वागत किया है। नॉर्थ जोन एसोसिएशन ऑफ हेल्थ केयर प्रोवाइडर्स ऑफ इंडिया के सचिव तथा आई.एम.ए. पंजाब के पूर्व अध्यक्ष डा. यश शर्मा ने कहा कि 'कई बीमारियों की जटिलताओं के कारण कई बार इलाज के दौरान रोगियों की मौत हो जाती थी, जिसके लिए डाक्टरों को दोगी तहराया जाता था, जबकि सभी डाक्टर अपने रोगियों को बेहतरीन चिकित्सा सुविधाएं उपलब्ध करवाते हैं।' उन्होंने कहा कि सुप्रीमकोर्ट ने 'जैकब मध्य मामले में अपना फैसला सुनाते हुए कहा था कि डाक्टरों के गले पर तलवार नहीं लटकनी चाहिए। डाक्टरों को स्वतंत्र मन से काम करने दिया जाना चाहिए और डाक्टरों को

Centre exploring one-stop health sector regulator

The Central government is exploring setting up a health sector regulator that will bring private and government health insurance schemes under its purview to facilitate affordable insurance coverage for all. The *Hindu* has learnt. The Ministries of Finance (MoF) and Health are in "initial discussions" over the need for a sector watchdog. The Association of Healthcare Providers India (AHP), in a letter to the

MoF, welcomed this saying "making healthcare available, accessible, and affordable has been resolved by the present government. Penetration of private insurance is increasing at a fast rate and along with government-run insurance, India should soon be covering 70% of the population". Doctors' bodies have urged that private and go-

vernment insurance be brought under a single regulator. Meaning, regulating government schemes like Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana, the Central Government Health Scheme, Employees' State Insurance Corporation, etc. Dr. Girdhar Gyani, DG, AHP, said, "This can only happen, if government insurance schemes are restructured in a manner that more and more tertiary care hospitals come forward and get empanelled in these schemes to enable beneficiaries to get health-care services".

This shift in initiation patterns raises serious concerns about the long-term health consequences and the potential for a new generation to be ensnared in the clutches of addiction. One critical aspect of this issue is the data suggesting that these New-Age Gateway Products are not a substitute for smoking as pushed by international tobacco companies but a distinct and powerful initiator of addiction of a different nature. Several studies indicate that the number of individuals trying vaping is fast surpassing those who take up

smoking. The allure of flavours, discreet packaging, and the misconception that vaping is less harmful contribute to its growing popularity, particularly among the youth. An Australian expert recently addressed the Members of the Scottish Parliament, shedding light on a disconcerting reality—the vaping industry seems to have a profound interest in cultivating a new generation of lifelong customers. The marketing strategies employed by these international tobacco companies are designed to appeal to younger demographics, creating a concerning link between the rise in vaping initiation and the long-term goals of these corporations. The expert's testimony emphasizes the urgent

need for regulatory measures to curb the influence of these entities on the youth. While traditional smoking has long been associated with health risks, these New-Age Gateway Products introduce a different set of concerns. E-cigarettes often contain high levels of nicotine, a highly addictive substance. The ease with which one can access and use these devices, coupled with enticing flavours, makes them particularly appealing to young individuals. It is not uncommon for those who start with vaping to transition to an addictive model soon, amplifying the potential for lifelong addiction and its associated health hazards. The World Health Organization (WHO) has also expressed apprehension about

the impact of vaping on public health. The organization highlights the need for comprehensive regulation to address the risks associated with these products, ranging from their appeal to minors to the potential for serving as a gateway to other substance use. Governments worldwide are grappling with the challenge of crafting policies that strike a balance between harm reduction for existing smokers and protecting the youth from the allure of vaping. In light of these findings, policymakers, public health officials, and communities must collaborate on effective strategies to curb the rising tide of initiation to New-Age Gateway Products. Education campaigns targeting both parents and students can play a pivotal

role in dispelling myths surrounding vaping and its perceived harmlessness. Additionally, stringent regulations must be put in place to restrict the marketing outreach of these New-Age Gateway Products companies that seem intent on creating a new generation of addicts. There is a need to advocate for a holistic approach around stringent enforcement on the ground to address the vaping epidemic. This includes robust educational initiatives, evidence-based policy reforms, and collaboration with experts and lawmakers to create a comprehensive framework that safeguards the well-being of our youth. By acknowledging the distinct threat posed by New-Age Gateway Products and taking decisive action, we

can work towards mitigating the long-term consequences of this burgeoning public health crisis. While it is alarming that a vast majority of children are unaware that these New-Age Gateway Products are already banned in India, access to these products seems to be at ease for those seeking them. Even law enforcement at the grassroots level needs to be made aware of this, or else porous and mis-declared imports into the country and their easy availability through those having access to school children can make this a serious upcoming health disaster waiting to happen.
